In today's Gospel, Our Lord speaks about being faithful in little things so that we may be trusted with greater ones. At first, it seems odd that he praises the shrewd steward, but Jesus is not encouraging dishonesty. Rather, he is showing us that the children of this world often put more energy into their affairs than the children of light put into living the Gospel.

The Lord invites us to consider: how do we use the gifts he has entrusted to us? Time, talents, and possessions are all part of the stewardship of a Christian life. We are not owners, but caretakers of what belongs to God. What matters most is not how much we have, but how faithfully we use it for God's glory and the service of others.

The prophet Amos reminds us that God's eye is always on the poor and the weak. When we use what we have in ways that build up others, especially the most vulnerable, then our lives become a witness to God's justice and mercy.

As we go into this new week, perhaps we can reflect on one small way of being faithful in the 'little things.' A kind word, an act of generosity, a moment of prayer: these are the treasures which build up our heavenly home, where Christ has prepared a place for us.
