FR GARY

Ten lepers cry out to Jesus, 'Master, take pity on us.' All ten are healed, yet only one turns back to give thanks. And that one, St Luke tells us, was a Samaritan.

The Gospel reminds us of the importance of gratitude. The nine received the gift of healing, but only one received the deeper gift of salvation. Our Lord says to him, 'Your faith has saved you.' Gratitude opens the soul to grace. When we give thanks, we acknowledge that everything we have comes from God, and in that act of humility we are drawn closer to Him.

There is something very moving in the picture of the healed Samaritan falling at the feet of Christ. His gratitude becomes worship; his thanksgiving becomes love. Every Mass is meant to bring us to that same posture of the heart. The very word *Eucharist* means 'thanksgiving'. Each time we come to the altar, we are the leper who has returned – healed, forgiven, and grateful.

In our lives, it is easy to take blessings for granted. We hurry from one concern to the next, noticing what is lacking rather than what has been given. Yet when we pause to thank God, for faith, for family, for the smallest daily gifts, we discover again the joy of being loved by Him.

Today, let us pray for hearts that are grateful, and for eyes that see the hand of God in all things. For to give thanks is to be truly alive in faith.

May God bless you and your families this week.
